EC 37.2.1: Brief on ongoing campus construction work (Ph-I, Pkg-I) at Yangang, South Sikkim

The Executive Engineer of the University presented an update on the ongoing campus construction work through a power point presentation in detail and explained the upcoming plan regarding the campus construction.

He informed that the Package-I of Phase-I is the current ongoing work comprises of only the basic building structures (skeleton) and no finishing items have been included in the package. The work has now been completed and ready to be handed over to the University by M/s NCC Ltd. The final billing work and other final financial settlement works are under progress. He further informed that the preparation of Engineering Procurement Contract (EPC) tender document for Phase-I Package-II of the Campus Construction project was under progress. The Phase-I Package-II would constitute of finishing works for the three structures constructed in Package-I, hostel blocks, residential blocks and classroom block along with other peripheral items.

The Council noted the progress in the campus development.

EC 37.4.4: MoU with Black Cat Division, Gangtok, East Sikkim

The Council was informed that 17 Mountain Division, a division of Indian Army, commonly known as "Black Cat Division" having its address at Gangtok, East Sikkim has approached Sikkim University for providing instructional guidance for its nominated officers posted in Eastern Command to undergo a course titled " Eastern Command Tibetology Cadre". They have proposed an MoU with the following salient features and objectives:

- The subjects that will be included in the "Eastern Command Tibetology Cadre" are the Political and Judicial Set Up in Tibet.
- The classes for the cadre will be conducted by the faculty members of Sikkim University.
- The exams and classes will be conducted at the Human Resource Development Centre of Gangtok Military Station.
- The annual curriculum would consist of three different categories comprising of a Trial Cadre for a duration of Two weeks, Four Long Cadres for a duration of Three Weeks & Two Short Cadres for a duration of Ten Days.
- The MoU will be valid for a period of one year from the date of its signing and may then be extended on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

The Council approved the MoU between Sikkim University and Black Cat Division.

EC 37.4.5: Revision of Recruitment & Promotion Rules for the post of Executive Engineer

The Council was informed that in the current Recruitment & Promotion Rules (Non-Teaching Staff) 2019 one of the essential prescribed qualifications for the post of Executive Engineer for both

Direct Recruitment and Promotion is eight years as Assistant Engineer. However, the prescribed UGC guidelines dated 14^{th} August 2015 has provided the qualifying service for promotion from Grade Pay of ₹4,600 (Assistant Engineer) to Grade Pay of ₹6,600 (Executive Engineer) (as per the 6th CPC) as seven years.

In view of the prescribed period of experience as suggested by the UGC, the Executive Council approved the revision of essential qualification for the post of Executive Engineer from eight years to seven years for Direct Recruitment and Promotion.

EC 37.4.6: ICC Report on an inquiry conducted on a complaint filed against Dr. Ram Bhawan Yadav, Assistant Professor, Department of English

The Council was informed that a complaint was filed by a PhD scholar from the Department of English against her supervisor Dr. Ram Bhawan Yadav, Assistant Professor, Department of English on 4th February 2021. The complaint was of physical, financial and emotional exploitation by her supervisor. Complaint was forwarded to the Presiding Officer, ICC on 5th February 2021. An inquiry based on the complaint was initiated by the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC).

Dr. Sandhya Thapa, Presiding Officer, ICC was called to present this item to the Council. She informed the Council that the ICC held a series of meetings/proceedings wherein personal hearing of the complainant, accused and various witnesses associated with the case including the faculty members of the Department were conducted.

The ICC also obtained legal advice and guidance from Justice (Retd.) A.P. Subba and submitted the inquiry report on 21st June 2021. The copy of the inquiry report was placed before the Council for its perusal.

It was observed by the Council that ICC after inquiry and after consideration of materials on record found that the complaint did not qualify to fall within the purview of The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. However, with reference to judgement of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in Bibha Pandey Vs. Punjab National Bank & Ors., WP(C) 3249/2017 & CM APPL 14126/2017 that stated:

"Moral policing is not the job of the ICC and that any consensual relationship among adults would not be the concern of the Management or of the ICC as long as the said relationship does not affect the working and the discipline of the organization and is not contrary to the rules or code of conduct binding on the said employees".

Going by the said judgement cited above, the ICC felt that as it clearly mentions that in the case relationship affects the working and the discipline of the organization and is contrary to the code of conduct binding on the said employees, then it would be the concern of the Management and the ICC. Therefore, the ICC found Dr. Ram Bhawan Yadav guilty of misconduct violating the provisions of the CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964 that he being an employee of this University committed gross moral misconduct by establishing relationship with the complainant which ought not have happen in an educational institution. Dr. Ram Bhawan Yadav being a teacher is expected to maintain integrity, high ethical standards and honesty and do nothing unbecoming of a Government servant at all times. A teacher student relationship is regarded as relation of respect in educational institutions and student enter higher educational institutions with a high expectation of getting quality education and build up their career.

Based on the views of the ICC, having found Dr. Ram Bhawan Yadav guilty of misconduct under CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964 and not of sexual harassment, the Executive Council recommended imposition of a minor penalty under rule 11 (iv), i.e. withholding of increments of pay for three years without cumulative effect. The same is to be restored at the end of the period of three years.

Additionally, the Council after detailed discussion also decided to impose the following penalties:

- i) Barring him from holding any administrative post or chair/member of any Committee in the University for three years.
- ii) Barring him from supervising any MPhil/PhD for 3 years including his current scholars under his supervision.
