Note:

1. Candidate must present physically at the venue on time (**Proxy attendance will not be considered**) and should strictly follow the COVID -19 Protocol (Wear masks all the time, maintain 6 feet distance, carry hand sanitizer etc.).
2. Only those candidates who have appeared and already applied online for the admission can attend the counselling. Candidates should bring a copy of self-attested online application form and a valid Photo ID proof (e.g. Voter ID etc.).
3. The vacancy in the respective programme may increase, if any candidate(s) withdraw(s) their admission before the day of counselling. In absence of the applicant in particular category, the seat(s) can be converted to other category or treated as Unreserved Seat.
4. If candidate(s) fails to reach the premises at the scheduled date and time (mentioned above) for the respective courses/department on the day of counselling, her/his candidature will not be entertained.
