The training program is intended to enhance the capacities of professionals and stakeholders working in the field of cryosphere, hydrology, and climate change studies as well as provide hands-on training. The training program shall consist of three weeks in-house hands-on training, that includes Geophysical Investigation of Lake and Springshed, Data Science for Environment, Black carbon induced Radiative forcing, Assessment of Glacial Lakes for GLOF Potential and AI/ML for Hydrological Modelling.

Targeted Participants

Postgraduate students, Ph.D. scholars, Postdoctoral researchers, scientists, and stakeholders working in the field of Water resource management/Cryosphere/Climate change studies can apply for the training program. The total number of seats available for this training program is 20. Candidates having prior knowledge/background in glaciology/water resource management/remote sensing/climate change studies will be given preference.

Travel and Accommodation:

This training program is fully funded by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India, under "DST's Centre of Excellence established at Department of Geology, Sikkim University. Selected participants will get reimbursement for train fare (AC III tier). Accommodation for selected participants in Gangtok for the course of the programme shall be provided.
