An online application is being invited for engagement of six Interns in the project titled “**Documenting Lepcha Oral Epics and Environmental Narratives of Sikkim through Digital Recording and Knowledge Mapping**”, sanctioned by the Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) Division, Ministry of Education, Government of India, under the BG Samvahan Karyakram-6: IKS Division Institutional Internship Program 2026–27, at the Department of Computer Applications, Sikkim University.

Essential Eligibility: The applicants must be between 16 and 30 years of age. The candidates must be pursuing or have completed UG/PG degree from a recognized university or must be students of Gurukulas. Independent scholars and recently graduated students, including those unaffiliated to any institution and those who have completed any degree within the past two years, are also eligible. Candidates from Lepcha, Linguistics, Language Studies, Folklore, Cultural Studies, Mass Communication, Journalism, Computer Applications, or any other relevant discipline may apply. Candidates having interest or experience in Lepcha language and culture, oral traditions, indigenous knowledge systems, field documentation, transcription, translation, digitization, archiving, metadata preparation, or knowledge mapping will be preferred.

Nature of Work: The selected interns may be involved in field documentation of Lepcha oral epics and environmental narratives, audio/video recording, data organization, transcription, translation, metadata creation, indexing, thematic classification, digitization, archival support, knowledge mapping, literature review, report writing, and preparation of project outputs under the guidance of the Principal Investigator.
